

Twin Oaks Lake Enhancement Project

Twin Oaks Village, Missouri

Intuition & Logic worked in partnership with the Village of Twin Oaks, Blaes Architects, and Environmental Strategies to develop construction documents for improvements to this community's one-and-only park. The park lake was originally constructed as a retention basin for nearby commercial development prior to creation of the park. As such, several large unsightly storm drain pipes were visible as well as the overflow structure. Additionally, frequent fluctuations in the lake level had caused erosion problems.



Plans were prepared that created features that would disguise the pipes and overflow structure, methods for reducing erosion were recommended, and recommendations for improving water quality were prepared. The result is the addition of a beautiful lakeside pavilion to hide the overflow structure, an observation deck and waterfalls to hide the storm drains, and fountains to aerate the lake and provide aesthetic appeal.



Our team developed the construction drawings, assisted the Village in selecting a contractor, and provided construction observation until completion.
